GEAR UP

Tickets

All guests are required to wear the ticket for the corresponding day in addition to a wristband which will be issued upon entry to the hospitality suite facilities. Singapore GP Pte Ltd reserves the right to refuse entry to any person who does not comply with this rule. After entry to the circuit, tickets are non-transferable for that day. Any tickets found to have been transferred will be immediately void.

Please ensure that both the ticket and wristband are worn at all times within the Circuit Park.

PATRONS WHO DO NOT WEAR AND PROMINENTLY DISPLAY THE CORRECT TICKET, LANYARD AND WRISTBAND AT ALL TIMES WILL BE ESCORTED OUT OF THE HOSPITALITY FACILITY.

Operation Hours

Please note that all hospitality suites will be available to guests 30 minutes after the Circuit Park gates officially opens, and will close 90 minutes after the end of the last track activity.

Do note that gate opening and closing hours may differ daily.

Getting There

- **MRT**

Via Nicoll Highway MRT (Circle Line)
Exit B to Gate 1

- **Taxi**

Temporary taxi stand created along Nicoll Highway, closer to Concourse Building.
Please take the overhead pass to Republic Boulevard to head to Gate 1

- **Self Drive**

- Park at The Concourse (cross overhead bridge over Nicoll Highway to Gate 1)
- Park at The Gateway (drive up Ophir Road flyover and turn left into Republic Avenue to Gate 1)

Kindly note that self drive parking options are at your own expense and subject to capacity.

What Not To Bring

For safety reasons, certain items are not permitted in the Circuit Park.

These include, but are not limited to,

- Any bulky items such as folding chairs, bicycles and scooters
- Remote controlled crafts and drones
- Corporate, commercial and brand-specific flags
- Laser pointers
- Pets
- Articles prohibited by Singapore law such as fireworks, flares and weapons.
- Videographic or photographic equipment for professional use

Guests are not permitted to bring in food or beverages. The hospitality experience includes meal services and an open bar.

Please note that all bags and all personnel will be checked at all gates.

Do also note that smoking is not permitted in the hospitality suites. Smoking will only be permitted in designated zones.

Release, Waiver And Discharge Of Liability And Indemnity Form For Children Below 7

Any person under 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised at all times by his or her parent/guardian who must also hold a valid ticket. Children below the age of seven (7) must not only hold a valid ticket, but will only be admitted if the parent/guardian signs a Form of Release, Waiver & Discharge of Liability And Indemnity Agreement. Both child and parent/guardian must hold a valid ticket.
